Ludwigshöhviertel – more ways to move, fewer cars

Cars will take a back seat in the Ludwigshöhviertel, opening up a range of eco-friendly ways for residents to get around:

By bike

- A dedicated bicycle lane running through the neighbourhood
- Numerous bicycle parking spaces

By tram

- A tram line running straight through the neighbourhood in the future
- Stops at Quartiersplatz and Sternenallee
- Direct links to Luisenplatz, Darmstadt Central Station and Eberstadt
- Temporary shuttle (Line 3A) between Ludwigshöhviertel and “Lichtenbergschule” tram stop

Other options

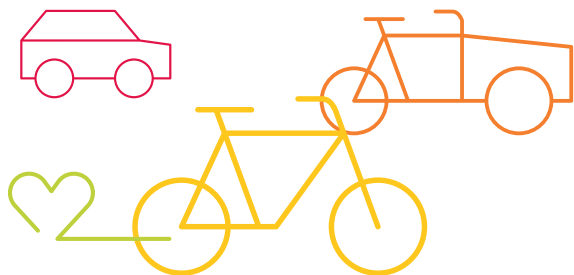
- Bike sharing
- Free cargo bike rental with *Heinerbike*
- Car sharing with *stadtmobil*
- On-demand shuttle service with HeinerLiner

By car

- Fair allocation of private parking spaces
- Three parking garages planned on the neighbourhood's edge:
P₁ (completion 2026), P₂ (2027),
P₃ (date TBD)
- Paid public parking spaces

On foot

- Shops, schools, daycare centres and services within walking distance
